At the Parish Mass on **Christ the King (25th November)**, the choir will be singing the whole of the mass composed by Pauline's father, Eric Wetherell. This will be a very special occasion when we will be celebrating our music tradition here at All Saints'. Do be there.

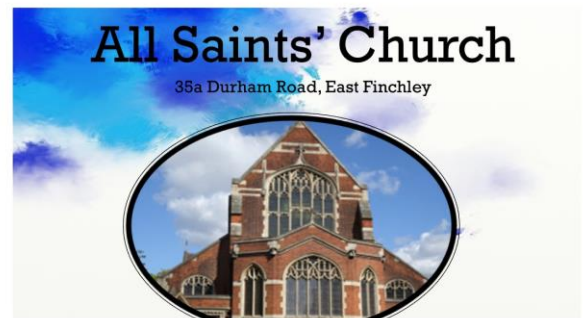
